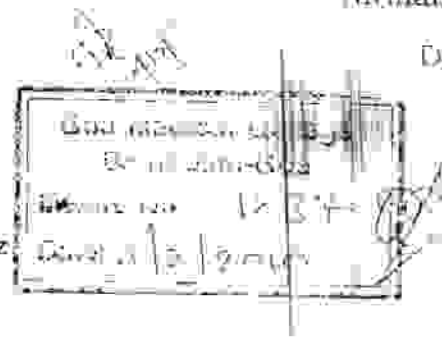

I am directed to state that the Central Govt. has recently modified the teacher student ratio from 1:1 to 1:2 by amending the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000. Accordingly, the Health Secretaries of all the States were requested by MCI to direct the Principals/Principals of Govt. Medical Colleges in their respective States to send the information with regard to availability of Professors in the subjects of broad specialities and availability of Professors & Associate Professors in respect of Super-specialities and also Unit wise number of existing beds & students. The information received from your college was considered by the Postgraduate Committee of Medical Council of India at its meeting held on 11/11/2009 in its 10th meeting in Gazette Notification dated 24/7/2009 and is now referred to this Ministry for issue of permission for enhancement of seats in various post graduate courses.

In view of the above, permission of the Central Government is granted for the following courses with annual intake mentioned against each course with effect from the academic year 2010-11 at the college under Section 17(1) of Act 1956.
