However, no increase of seats to be made without prior approval of the Council. Since Goa Medical College, Panaji was earlier affiliated to Bombay University and permitted by the Council to start various postgraduate medical courses under that University, therefore, the Postgraduate Committee recommends that Goa Medical College, Panaji be approved for the award of the above qualifications earlier granted by Bombay University."
