Sir,

I am to state that the Council Inspectors reports (July, 89/June, 90) on the standard of examination and the facilities for teaching existing at Goa Medical College, Panaji together with the observations of the University and recommendations of the Postgraduate Committee for purposes of recognition of M.S. (General Surgery) and M.D. (Anaesthesiology) granted by Goa University were duly placed before the Council at its meeting held on 4th Jan., 1992, for consideration.
