S.O. In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of the section 11 of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 (102 of 1956), the Central Government, after consulting the Medical Council of India, hereby makes the following further amendments in the First Schedule to the said Act.

In the said First Schedule after "Goa University, Goa" and under the heading 'Recognised Medical Qualification' [hereinafter referred to as column (2)], after the last entry and entry relating thereto under the heading 'Abbreviation for Registration' [hereinafter referred to as column (3)], the following shall be inserted, namely:-

(This shall be a recognised medical qualification when granted by Goa University, Goa in respect of students being trained at Goa Medical College, Goa on or after 1994.

- Note to all:

 2. The procedure for 'Renewal' of recognition shall be same as applicable for the award of recognition.
 3. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as provided in sub-clause 4 shall automatically result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Postgraduate Course.
